“A MOTHER PRAYS”

Introduction: A “good Mother”

I. A Mother Committed to God

A time of spiritual decline in Israel

1 Samuel 1:2, “He had two wives”. What could go wrong?

Hannah and her “rival”, v.6. Hannah “prayed” (1:10, 12; 2:1)

1:27 “The LORD gave my asking which I asked of him.”

II. A Mother Concerned About Character

2:1, “my heart exults in the LORD”

2:3, “by his actions are weighed”

Proverbs 1:7, 8

III. A Mother Who Trusted God

2:9 “He will guard”

Hannah knew Samuel’s future was in the hands of God

2:19, “a little robe”

Hannah trusted God who “raises up” (v.8)

A Mother’s Influence

Conclusion: God uses Hannah in “a series of events that helped turn back the spiritual darkness.”
